

# Victoria Borwick MP – Notting Hill Carnival

## METHODOLOGY NOTE

The survey was designed and distributed by Victoria Borwick MP, who sent postal questionnaires to all 15,000 homes in and around the Carnival footprint between 9<sup>th</sup> January and 20<sup>th</sup> February 2016. The survey was also accessible online. 1,026 valid survey responses were received before the 29<sup>th</sup> February 2016 deadline (974 paper, 52 online), excluding 18 duplicates which were removed (where a respondent used the same name, address, and/or email address twice or more). ComRes were supplied with full data, including all returned paper copies, and ComRes ran integrity checks to confirm that data were inputted correctly, coded open-ended questions and produced data tables representing the results.
