
Next Thursday here in Chingford and Woodford Green we aren't just deciding who will govern us for the next five years but who will lead this great country through some of the most difficult decisions we will have to make.

Just imagine what would happen if, by you not voting Conservative, Jeremy Corbyn became the Prime Minister at the head of a coalition with Nicola Sturgeon, Tim Farron, the Greens and Plaid Cymru?

Immediately, the pound would fall, sending inflation higher, interest rates would have to rise which would push up the cost of mortgages – all before negotiations with the EU even start. Perhaps most dangerous to us all though is Corbyn's attitude to our safety. In the last 30 years Corbyn has;

- Opposed every single bit of anti-terrorism legislation

- Chaired the “Stop the War” coalition which supported those attacking British troops in Iraq
